Guidelines for providing Agronomy services by MIS suppliers to beneficiary farmers:

Providing agronomical services is compulsory on MIS suppliers part which primarily consists of training to beneficiary farmers for proper maintenance and operation of drip category (i.e. Drip irrigation, Mini sprinkler, Porous pipe, Drip tape) irrigation and to give agronomic advisory and guidance to grow crop successfully under drip irrigation system. The agronomy services should be provided for one year from the date of trial run of the MI system.

The agronomist will be required to visit beneficiary farmers once in a quarter. However if need be on call by farmer agronomist should visit frequently. The visiting agronomist will be required to get acknowledgment of services/advisory they have provided to the farmer by getting signed KRUSHI VISHAYAK SEVA/ MAHITI PRAMANPATRA. This KRUSHI VISHAYAK SEVA/ MAHITI PRAMANPATRA consists of the following aspects:

1. Pre-Sowing Advisory: According to the crop and type of soil, information for primary and secondary tillage, land leveling, farm manure, basal dose etc.
2. Selection of variety of seed, seed rate, time of sowing, row to row spacing etc.
3. Irrigation water management, Irrigation scheduling.
4. Integrated nutrient management, use of water soluble fertilizer, micronutrients and fertigation scheduling.

5. Integrated pest control: Type of pest and dosage of pesticides/ bio-pesticides to control it.
6. Integrated disease control: Type of diseases, dosage of fungicide, viricide, bactericide to control it.
7. Maintenance of MIS system and solution of farmers query.
8. Information on crop rotation, cropping pattern and inter crop.
9. Weed control.
10. Any other advisory except mentioned above like acid treatment and repairing advisory to drip irrigation system etc.
